## WHO WE ARE

BioPharmaceutical Emerging Best Practices Association (BEBPA) is a non-profit organization managed by and for the benefit of the biopharmaceutical scientific community.

## HISTORY OF FOUNDING

The genesis of BEBPA came from a number of scientists from various companies, institutes and regulatory agencies. As our discussions matured we realized that despite the various venues for meetings and publication, there was no place for new approaches and ideas about common problems to be openly discussed and vetted without firms worrying that their comments would be taken as corporate policy.

Each individual expressed the belief that something should be done about this – and that if something were done by the industry as a whole, then the individual companies involved would benefit immensely. We decided that 2008 was the year to do something and thus BEBPA was born.

## BEBPA MISSION

BEBPA provides an international forum for the presentation and discussion of scientific issues and problems encountered in the biopharmaceutical community. The aim of this open discussion is to promote development of innovative approaches and solutions thus

facilitating safer and faster biopharmaceutical product development. This results in biopharmaceuticals which are safer and more readily available for patients.

The current platforms for this critical open communication include:

**In person/Hybrid large topic conferences with podium talks, posters, workshops, interest groups and networking events.**

**Highly focused virtual conferences to address specific issues being faced by the entire or particular subsections of the industry**

**Publication of short technical articles in a monthly blog available free of charge to the industry**

**Publication of white papers**

**Publication of industry surveys which assess the current state of the analytical practices within the biopharmaceutical industry.**

BEBPA foster discussions to clarify problems faced by biopharmaceutical community – companies, regulators, clinicians – during product development. We strive to identify emerging issues which would benefit from early discussion. Conferences are held on these topics and a non-consensus white papers are published delineating various approaches to solving these problems. The papers strive to present the scientific community with a variety

of approaches to potentially solve a common problem. The papers are not consensus documents, nor prescribe a single preferred approach, but present the scientific discussion occurring within the BEBPA community and present it to the industry as a whole. We have seen that the publication and discussion about various problem-solving approaches accelerates the rate at which consensus best practice are eventually established.
